# LANDSCAPE COMMITTEE UPDATE

This does not include a bush that is growing over your front arche. If you "do not" wish for a bush to be trimmed, it is your responsibility to mark such a bush on Monday morning. Also, a homeowner is not permitted to remove vegetation in the front yard without prior approval from the HOA. If so, the vegetation will have to be replaced at the homeowner's expense.
